
Jaguar XX741 lives!!!


With today being the 50th anniversary of the first flight of the Anglo-French Jaguar, it seemed the perfect day for Bentwaters Cold War Museum to celebrate the anniversary in style. The museum's Jaguar airframe XX741, that has been under restoration to become a live ground runner for 9 years, was towed out of its hangar for its first engine runs during its restoration phase. This would make XX741 fully 'live' and a functional exhibit. The day saw mixed success, with one engine having starting issues with its fuel system. However the other Adour was successfully started and ran comfortably into the higher power ranges including lighting of its afterburner. Several major aircraft systems were also proven including electrical generation that allowed the aircraft to operate without external power supplies. A great day for all those involved with the restoration of XX741 and the BCWM.



Got time for a walk?








New addition to the BCWM Aircraft Fleet!






RAF100 Baton Relay - June 25th 2018


Opening Times & Prices for 2018:
